Powerhouse Manufacturing Sector Leaders Honored at South Florida's Manufacturing (SFMA) Recognition of Excellence Gala

Top Players in the Industry Showcase Innovation, Leadership and Economic Growth for South Florida

MIAMI, Fla. - The South Florida Manufacturers Association (SFMA) dazzled attendees at its 45th Recognition of Excellence Ceremony on June 20, 2024, honoring the region's manufacturing powerhouses and top talent. Since 1961, SFMA has held the distinction of being the #1 resource for South Florida manufacturers, saving its members time and money through advocacy, networking, and resources.

Presented by Randstad, the event's highlight was the prestigious 2024 Manufacturer-ofthe-Year and Employee of the Year awards.
